Paying the Code Enforcement lien(s) DOES NOT resolve tax sales or tax sale adjudications. Paying the Code Enforcement Lien DOES NOT prevent you from losing ownership of your property due to tax sale or tax sale adjudication.
- **Demolition and Grass Costs can't be reduced other than interest:** The principal amount and recordation fees of demolition and lot abatement costs may not be reduced other than reducing interest added after placement on the tax bill.
- Lien Foreclosure properties filed in court from 01/01/2011 to 12/31/2015 are eligible for reduction: Code Enforcement Liens filed in court, from 2016 to present, are NOT eligible for reduction.
- You MUST include all judgments that you want considered for reduction. Information provided does not take the place of a title search or a payoff on all items that may be owed to Code Enforcement.
